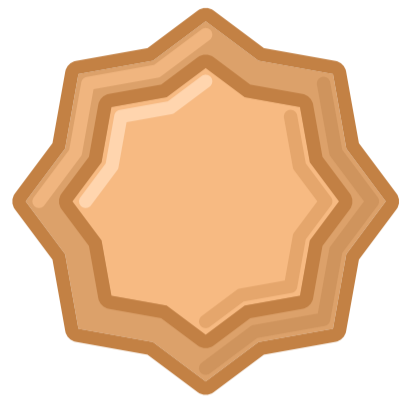


Course Rep Award Criteria

Here are the criteria you need to meet to achieve a bronze, silver or gold Course Rep Award.
The list at the bottom details all the types of engagement activities.



Bronze Award

Take part in six engagement activities from the list.



Silver Award

Take part in eight engagement activities from the list.



Gold Award

Take part in fourteen engagement activities from the list.

Must include:

- Course Rep Training
- 1 x SSLC meeting
- 1 x Course Rep Forum.

Must include:

- Course Rep Training
- 1 x SSLC meeting
- 2 x Course Rep Forums.
- Attend Rep Conference *

Must include:

- Course Rep Training
- 1 x SSLC meeting
- 2 x Course Rep Forums.
- Attend Rep Conference *
- Attend the Students' Union all Student Meeting.

What counts as an engagement activity?

**You do not need to attend all of the conference but must be present for at least one session.*

- Course Rep Training
- SSLC meetings
- Course Rep Forum
- Rep Conference*
- Students' Union All Student Meeting
- Completing a Rep Journal
- Attending a Rep-drop in session with the Students' Union.
- Having a meeting with your Academic Representation Coordinator (ARC)
- Attending a Course Rep meeting hosted by your school.
- Miscellaneous – considered on an individual basis. E.g. joining a campaign group with the VPE, running a Rep Stall.
